PROVISIONAL VISITOR ARRIVALS – FEBRUARY 2019

Provisional numbers show that visitor arrivals for February 2019 totaled 48,748, a slight decrease of 0.1% compared to a year earlier.

There were decreases in the number of visitors from the following countries; Australia [down 1,525 or 9.0% to 15,489]; China [down 454 or 6.9% to 6,113]; Continental Europe [down 327 or 12.2% to 2,355] and the United States of America [down 96 or 1.6% to 5,855].

Increases were recorded in the number of visitors from Japan [693 or 135.9% to 1,203]; Pacific Islands [595 or 13.5% to 5,011]; New Zealand [504 or 7.6% to 7,145]; Rest of Asia [414 or 24.7% to 2,092]; South Korea [124 or 22.4% to 677]; United Kingdom [123 or 9.8 to 1,375] and Canada [30 or 3.0% to 1,023].

Visitors arriving for holiday purposes accounted for 69.6% of total arrivals, 9.5% came to visit their friends or relatives 4.8% came for business purposes, while 16.1% visited Fiji for other reasons.

Table 1 below presents actual numbers and the 2019 and 2018 comparisons of visitor arrivals for the month of February, six months to February and twelve months to February 2019.



Note: Visitor statistics are released monthly using data sourced from the Immigration System. The limited number of tables released is due to the new system which came on line in April 2013.

Figure 1 below is a graphical comparison of Visitor Arrivals by Country for February 2019 and 2018.

In the moving twelve monthly numbers ending February 2019, the total number of visitors to Fiji increased by 3.1% compared with the same period in 2018. Visitors from Japan increased by [118.2%]; Rest of Asia [8.8%]; New Zealand [7.4%]; Canada [6.1%]; Continental Europe [5.5%] and the United States of America [5.4%].

Decreases were recorded for visitors from South Korea [6.3%]; Pacific Islands [3.0%]; the United Kingdom [2.7%]; Australia [0.4%]; Other Countries [0.3%] and China [0.2%].

The moving six months to February 2019, showed that visitor arrivals increased by 1.4% over the corresponding period in 2018, up from 409,220 to 415,128.






The majority of visitors to Fiji in February 2019 were in the age range 25-64 (68.7%), which accounts for the vast majority of the working age population. Youths aged 15-24 accounted for 11.6% of the February visitor arrivals; 9.9% comprising those in the predominantly retirement age group of 65 and over with the remaining 9.8% were Children aged 14 and below.

Figure 4 below shows a significant gender differential in the age groups 15-19, 20-24, 25-29, 35-39, 40-44, 45-49, 50-54, 55-59 and 65+;

Visitors by Occupation

For the month of February 2019 the top 5 Occupational Groups for visitors engaged in gainful employment in their home countries are as follows;


- 1) Service Workers increased by [425 or 13.6% to 3,542].
- 2) Legislators increased by [396 or 5.7% to 7,304].
- 3) Professional Workers decreased by [609 or 5.8% to 9,938].
- 4) Technician and Related Workers decreased by [322 or 5.8% to 5,242].
- 5) Clerical Workers decreased by [107 or 6.0% to 1,671].

February 2019 visitors who are not in the labour force were categorised into two major groups. The categories and numbers are as follows;

- 1) Retirees, Housewives, Children & Others increased by [154 or 1.7% to 9,463].
- 2) Students decreased by [10 or 0.1% to 7,660].

A total of 15,361 Fiji Residents departed our shores during the month of January of which 12,268 or 79.9% were for a short-term absence of under three months. A total of 1,160 or 7.6% of resident departures were for a longer term absence of 1 year or more.

The reasons for departure as reported by residents leaving for a short-term absence were as follows;

- Holiday 49.7%
- Visiting Friends or Relatives 33.1%
- Business − 8.2%
- Employment 5.6%
- Education/Training 3.0%.
