PROVISIONAL VISITOR ARRIVALS – JANUARY 2019

Provisional numbers show that visitor arrivals for January 2019 totaled 63,807, an increase of 1.9% compared to a year earlier.

Increases were recorded in the number of visitors from New Zealand [961 or 9.1% to 11,573]; Japan [622 or 123.2% to 1,127]; China [207 or 5.5% to 3,964]; Canada [121 or 12.1% to 1,121]; the United States of America [92 or 1.6% to 5,709] and Rest of Asia [30 or 1.7% to 1,842].

There were decreases in the number of visitors from the following countries; Australia [down 453 or 1.6% to 27,860]; Pacific Islands [down 326 or 5.9% to 5,203]; the United Kingdom [down 56 or 4.2% to 1,265]; Continental Europe [down 46 or 1.6% to 2,906] and South Korea [down 26 or 3.3% to 766].

Visitors arriving for holiday purposes accounted for 73.8% of total arrivals, 8.7% came to visit their friends or relatives 3.0% came for business purposes, while 14.5% visited Fiji for other reasons.

Table 1 below presents actual numbers and the 2019 and 2018 comparisons of visitor arrivals for the month of January, six months to January and twelve months to January 2019.



Note: Visitor statistics are released monthly using data sourced from the Immigration System. The limited number of tables released is due to the new system which came on line in April 2013.

Figure 1 below is a graphical comparison of Visitor Arrivals by Country for January 2019 and 2018.

In the moving twelve monthly numbers ending January 2019, the total number of visitors to Fiji increased by 3.7% compared with the same period in 2018. Visitors from Japan increased by [99.8%]; Rest of Asia [7.9%]; Continental Europe [7.6%]; New Zealand [7.4%]; Canada [6.7%]; Other Countries [6.5%]; China [6.1%]; the United States of America [6.0%]; and Australia [0.4%].

Decreases were recorded for visitors from South Korea [8.6%]; Pacific Islands [4.6%] and the United Kingdom [3.9%].

The moving six months to January 2019, showed that visitor arrivals increased by 2.8% over the corresponding period in 2018, up from 442,738 to 455,073.






The majority of visitors to Fiji in January 2019 were in the age range 25-64 (61.9%), which accounts for the vast majority of the working age population. Children aged 14 and below accounted for 18.6% of the January visitor arrivals; 13.0% were youths aged 15-24 with the remaining 6.5% comprising those in the predominantly retirement age group of 65 and over.

Figure 4 below shows a significant gender differential in the age groups 15-19, 20-24, 25-29, 35-39, 40-44, 45-49, 50-54, 55-59 and 65+;

Visitors by Occupation

For the month of January 2019 the top 5 Occupational Groups for visitors engaged in gainful employment in their home countries are as follows;


- 1) Clerical Workers increased by [432 or 26.3% to 2,076].
- 2) Professional Workers increased by [403 or 3.3% to 12,632].
- 3) Service Workers increased by [208 or 4.1% to 5,270].
- 4) Technician and Related Workers decreased by [303 or 5.5% to 5,251].
- 5) Legislators decreased by [117 or 1.4% to 8,231].

January 2019 visitors who are not in the labour force were categorised into two major groups. The categories and numbers are as follows;

- 1) Retirees, Housewives, Children & Others increased by [1,140 or 11.9% to 10,684].
- 2) Students decreased by [360 or 2.3% to 15,261].

A total of 22,850 Fiji Residents departed our shores during the month of December of which 19,973 or 87.4% were for a short-term absence of under three months. A total of 1,115 or 4.9% of resident departures were for a longer term absence of 1 year or more.

The reasons for departure as reported by residents leaving for a short-term absence were as follows;

- Holiday 59.9%
- Visiting Friends or Relatives 30.4%
- Business -6.4%
- Employment 1.8%
- Education/Training 1.5%.
