The InterContinental Fiji Golf Resort and Spa opened on the 09th of May 2009 and today we celebrate our 10th birthday.

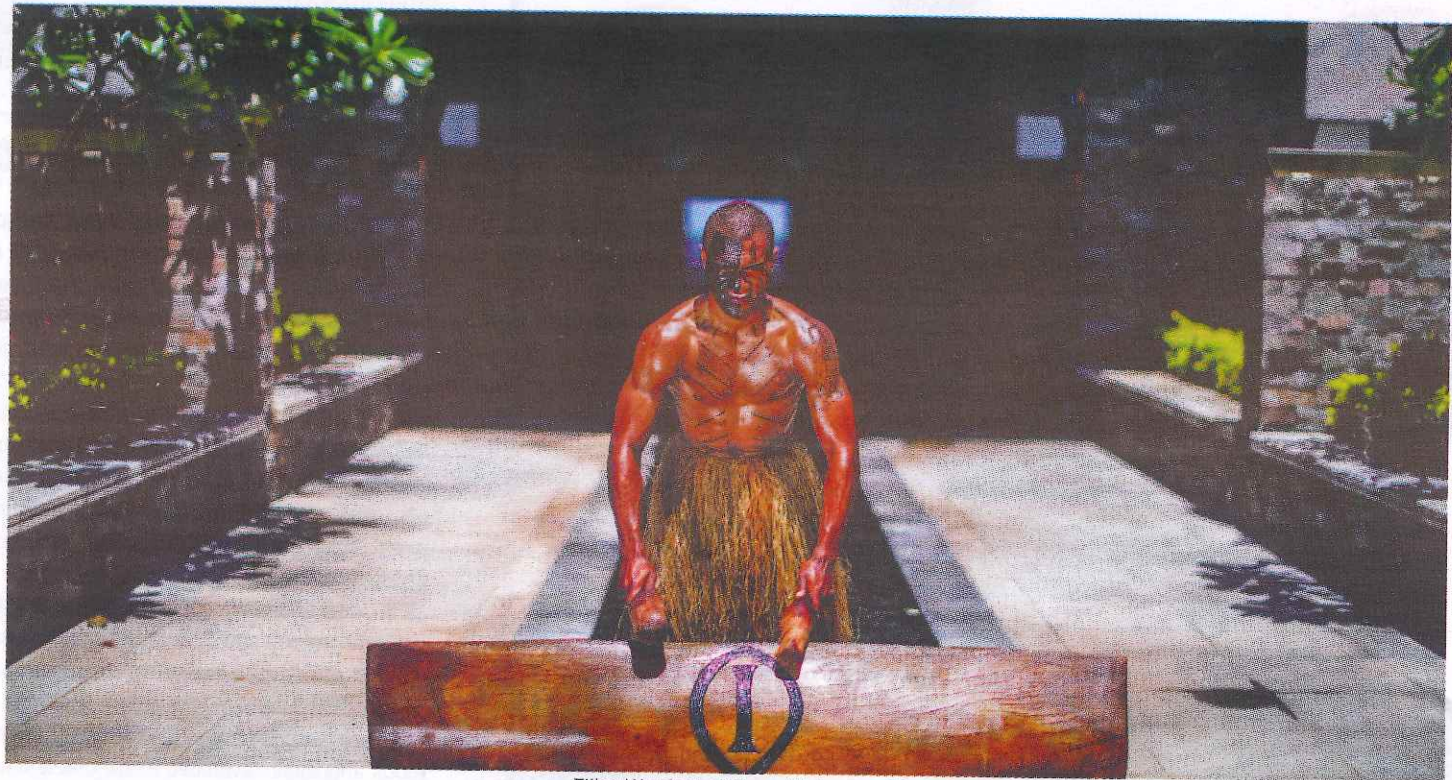
