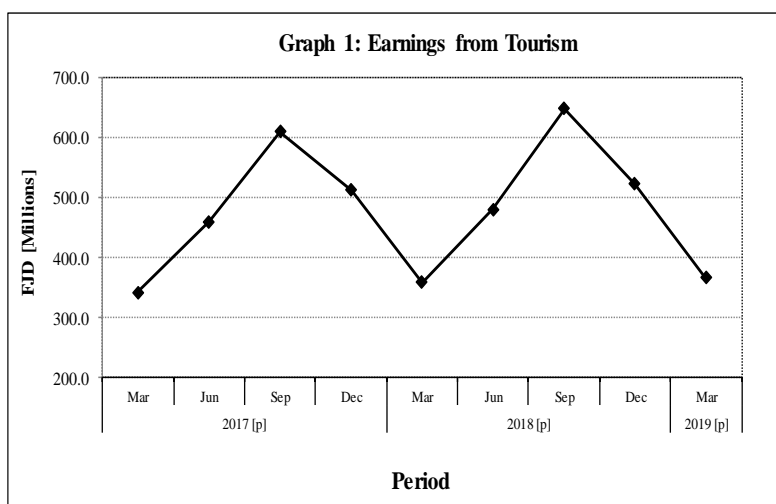
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FIJI'S EARNINGS FROM TOURISM

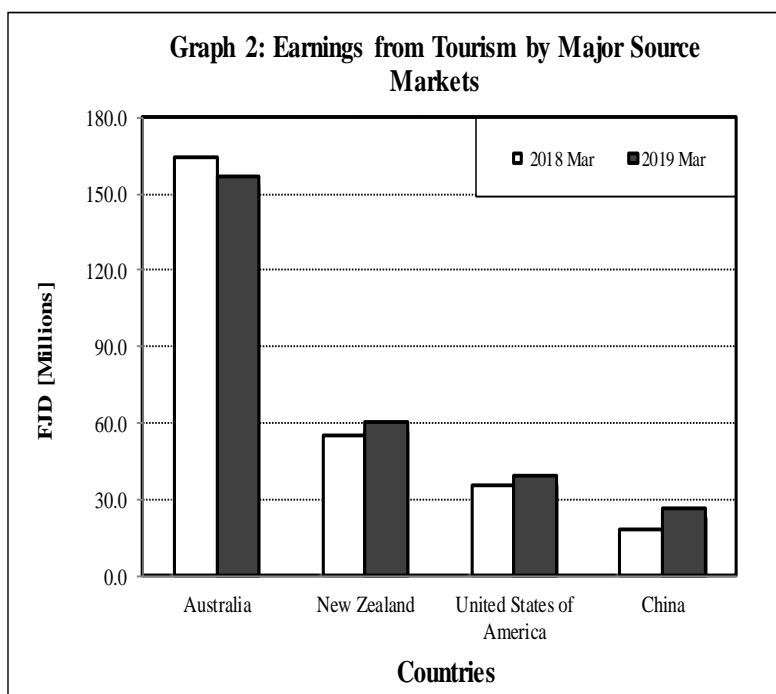
March Quarter 2019

Fiji's Earnings from Tourism indicate the spending of our international visitors. The figure is derived from an estimated average daily spend of visitors (per diem) and the total visitor days in Fiji.



Key Facts

- Fiji's earnings from tourism stood at \$366.6 million for the March quarter of 2019, an increase of 2.3 percent (\$8.4 million) over the March quarter of 2018.
- The March quarter 2019 earnings was 29.9 percent (\$156.3 million) lower than the amount recorded for the December quarter of 2018.



Compared to the March quarter of 2018, the major changes in earnings recorded by country were as follows:

- Australia down by 4.7 percent (\$7.8 million) to \$157.0 million contributing 42.8 percent to the total;
- New Zealand up by 8.5 percent (\$4.7 million) to \$60.1 million contributing 16.4 percent to the total;
- United States of America up by 10.8 percent (\$3.8 million) to \$39.0 million contributing 10.6 percent to the total; and
- China up by 47.2 percent (\$8.5 million) to \$26.5 million contributing 7.2 percent to the total.


These countries accounted for 77.1 percent of earnings in the March quarter of 2019, an increase of 0.8 percentage point when compared to the March quarter of 2018.
