

Luxury waterfront apartments to be ready by early next year

THE construction of a luxury waterfront apartment complex in Lami is almost complete and the first units available for lease will be ready by early next year, according to its property manager.

Blue Horizon Property Group says it expects a great deal of interest in the Uduya Point Apartments in Lami given the undersupply of luxury apartments in the market.

The complex, developed by Pacific Building Solutions (PBS), will have 26 fully-furnished apartments, comprising a mixture of studio, one-bedroom, two-bedroom and three-bedroom units.

PBS is also expecting to complete the construction of Tamavua Estates, a boutique collection of four luxury apartments, in Suva by the end of this year, according to a press release by Blue Horizon Property Group.
