



Ocean View Hotel Rooms classified No Smoking Area

Plantation Island Resort is pleased to announce that it will be classifying the Ocean View Hotel Room category, which opened on 1 September 2019, a “No Smoking Zone” effective immediately.

Smoking will not be allowed inside the rooms, on the patio/balcony, on the pathways or within 20 meters of the blocks of accommodation. Resident guests of this room category who would like to smoke will be able to do so in public spaces that are not within 20 meters of the accommodations.

“We regularly receive feedback from our guests asking us to make our accommodation no-smoking areas” says Director of Sales & Marketing, Akshay Singh. “As our Ocean View Hotel Rooms are a higher density accommodation type with rooms in blocks of 4, it made perfect sense to classify this accommodation category no smoking in the health interests of the resident guests of this category”.

The No Smoking classification of the Ocean View Hotel Rooms will be clearly listed on Plantation Island Resort’s website and all marketing materials. Plantation Island Resort will also have sufficient signage in and around the rooms to ensure that all guests are aware of this policy.
